

Admission Questionnaire for Physicians (M.D. / Dr.med.)

Name of Applicant

Pre-requisite for applying for Alexander von Humboldt Foundation research fellowships and for a Sofja Kovalevskaja Award is a doctorate or a comparable academic degree (Ph.D., C.Sc. or equivalent). For the purposes of the Humboldt Foundation, a doctorate is understood to mean a "research doctorate". A research doctorate differs from a professional doctorate in that, as a rule, it can only be attained through full-time, independent scientific research activity lasting several years. In all cases in which this is not the generally accepted pre-requisite for attaining a doctorate, the Humboldt Foundation will not accept such a doctoral degree without examining its status as a "doctorate or comparable academic degree". The M.D. / Dr. med. qualifications also fall within this category.

This is the reason why the Humboldt Foundation examines whether an applicant has a research doctorate or whether, if applicable, an equivalent qualification can be recognised. For this purpose, please complete the form below. To be recognised as a **research doctorate** your doctorate must meet all the criteria mentioned in Case 1, otherwise it is deemed to be a "professional doctorate". Applicants with a professional doctorate as the highest academic degree are not excluded from admission, but they will have to provide proof of additional qualifications equivalent to a doctorate.

Please also use the table below to ascertain the **date of doctorate** to be entered in the application form in your own case. This date is used to calculate the **period of time since attaining the doctorate** and determines which of the programme lines you are eligible to apply for: "post-doctoral researchers" or "experienced researchers".

The **date of doctorate** refers to the date of the last action required to complete the doctorate, e.g. viva voce or the defence of the doctoral thesis. Usually, this date is recorded on the certificate in addition to the date of issue. The **period of time since attaining the doctorate** equals the difference between the date of doctorate and the date the application is received at the Humboldt Foundation and in the Sofja Kovalevskaja Program the difference between the date of the doctorate and the application submission deadline.
