



Information on the German Chancellor Fellowship and the Humboldt Foundation

Dear Sir or Madam,

This letter has been sent to you by an applicant for a German Chancellor Fellowship of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation who would like you to become a collaborative partner and host. We want to assist our applicants with their search for a host and would thus like to provide you with a brief portrait of the Foundation and the fellowship. - Each applicant requires a binding commitment and a letter of recommendation from their host in order to apply for the fellowship. You will find the requisite form on our website.
- Should the applicant be awarded a fellowship, you will provide an appropriate workplace.

Your advantages as host:

- As a result of this collaboration you will benefit from additional professional stimuli and will be able to continue expanding your international network.
- You will become part of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation's worldwide network and profit from sponsorship opportunities even after the project has been completed.
- You will receive a monthly allowance for research costs of €500.
