1) Activities of Humboldt Ambassador Scientists abroad

The Alexander von Humboldt Foundation's Ambassador Scientists abroad often work together closely with alumni associations in their own countries as well as other Ambassador Scientists in the same country or region. They are not only the contact person for the Humboldt Foundation, its alumni and future fellows, but also for the Foundation's partner organisations. The activities of Ambassador Scientists abroad are very diverse. They ...

... inform	Information material <ul style="list-style-type: none">- They manage <u>exhibition stands</u> providing information, e.g. at academic fairs- They distribute <u>printed information material</u> at universities and other institutions- They disseminate information about the Humboldt Foundation using their own universities' <u>intranet, website or newsletter</u> (e.g. by linking the Foundation to their websites)- They send out <u>info emails</u>- They often <u>translate</u> the Humboldt Foundation presentation and other information on the Foundation's programmes into the languages of their own countries Information events <ul style="list-style-type: none">- They organise and participate in events providing information about the Humboldt Foundation and its programmes Short presentations <ul style="list-style-type: none">- They deliver short talks on the Humboldt Foundation and its programmes (at conferences and meetings as well as lectures and seminars)
... advise	Personal advice <ul style="list-style-type: none">- They personally <u>advise junior researchers and potential candidates</u> for Humboldt sponsorship (in some cases in collaboration with DAAD branch offices)- <u>They advise the Humboldt Foundation</u> on how to customise marketing measures and possibly adapt sponsorship programmes for the respective country (based on application figures and the response from the respective country)

... network (in person and virtually)	Networking <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - They <u>create a virtual platform</u> to connect Humboldtians in a given country (in collaboration with alumni associations) (e.g. creating a website in the respective language, setting up a group in the "Humboldt Life" <u>section on the Alumniportal Deutschland</u>) - They <u>welcome /contact newly selected fellows</u> in their own countries, offering help with any questions or problems - They help and <u>participate in founding new Humboldt alumni associations</u> in their own countries - They <u>help to initiate cooperation</u> between agencies, institutions for the promotion of research or businesses in their own countries and the Humboldt Foundation and other partners in Germany - They are in contact/ cooperate with the German Houses of Science and Innovation
... organise	Events <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - They organise and <u>help organise events</u> (e.g. Humboldt Kollegs or Humboldt Colloquia)
