

INTERNATIONAL CLIMATE PROTECTION FELLOWSHIPS

For prospective leaders and postdocs with climate expertise from transition and developing countries interested in conducting a project in Germany



The fellowship allows climate experts to spend up to two years in Germany working on a project of their own choice in the field of climate protection. Fellows are free to choose their own hosts. Submit an application if you come from a non-European

transition or developing country and are involved with issues relating to the scientific, engineering, legal, economic, health-related or social aspects of climate change. The fellowships are funded under the German government's International Climate Initiative (IKI).

Requirements

- academic degree (Bachelor or comparable degree) during the last 12 years
- initial experience in a leadership role
- extensive theme-related professional experience or a successfully completed doctorate
- mentoring agreement signed by a host in Germany

Benefits

- monthly fellowship amount between €2,170 and €2,670
- three-week introductory seminar, several-day training course
- up to 2 months intensive German course
- family allowances, lump sum for travel expenses
