- 2,650 EUR per month
- doctoral degree within the last 4 years
- research stay in Germany: 6–24 months

Fellowship for experienced researchers

- 3,150 EUR per month
- doctoral degree within the last 12 years
- research stay in Germany: 6–18 months, divisible into three stays
